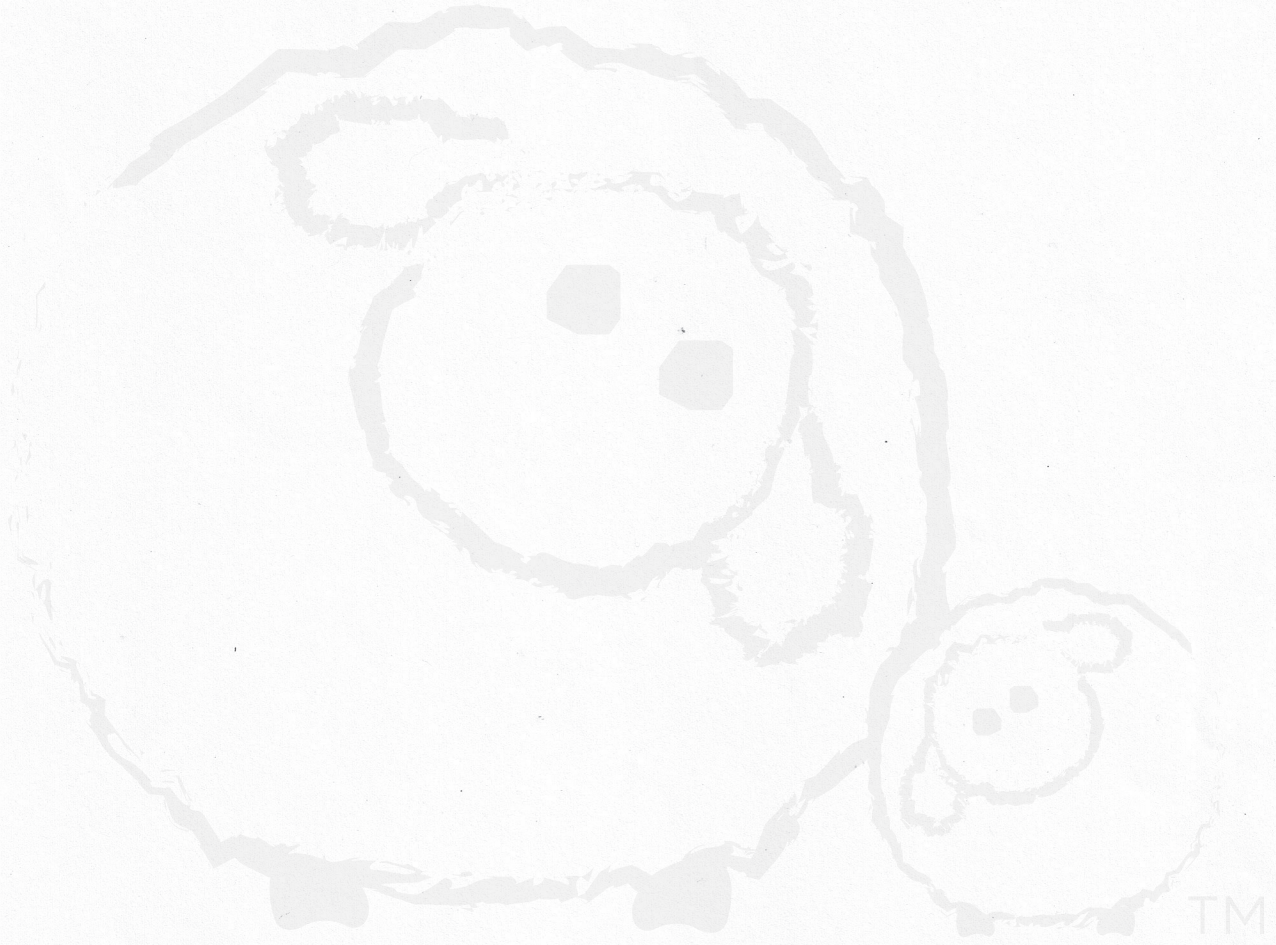

Somerset and Hereford being Defender of the Faith the Sheriff

of our County of Middlesex greeting we command
you that you to the Sheriff of the County of Middlesex
within your Bailiwick and him safely to keep so that
you have his Body before the Judges of our County Court for the
place at North Amboy in and for the County of Middlesex on the
third Tuesday in April next to answer for Joseph Threlwell and
Thomas Moore of a plea of Treasons on the back to the Damage of the said Joseph
and Moore twenty pounds proclamation made as is said
and have you then and there this writ with the same Joseph
and Moore of our said Court at North Amboy answered in the
County aforesaid the Nineteenth day of January in the third year
of our said King
